

BHOC26 Ticket Terms & Conditions

Behavioral Health Outcomes Consortium 2026 (BHOC26)

These Terms & Conditions (“Terms”) govern your purchase of tickets and attendance at the Behavioral Healthcare Outcomes Consortium 2026 (“BHOC26” or the “Event”). By purchasing a ticket, you acknowledge and agree to these Terms in full.

1. Ticketing & Payment

- All tickets must be purchased through the official BHOC26 registration system.
- Tickets are valid only for the named attendee unless properly transferred (see Section 2).
- Tickets may not be resold, copied, or used for promotional purposes without the organizers’ prior written consent.

2. Refund & Transfer Policy

Refunds:

- Full refunds will be granted for requests made on or before June 15, 2026.
- Partial refunds (50%) will be granted for requests made between June 16 and July 31, 2026.
- No refunds will be issued for requests made on or after August 1, 2026, or for no-shows.

Transfers:

- Tickets may be transferred to another individual at no additional cost.
- Transfer requests must be submitted by August 25, 2026 by emailing info@bhoc.com with the full name and contact information of the new attendee.

Event Cancellation or Postponement:

- In the unlikely event BHOC26 is canceled or postponed due to unforeseen circumstances (including but not limited to natural disasters, public health emergencies, or government restrictions), ticket holders will be notified immediately. Options will include:
 - A full refund, or
 - Application of the ticket to the rescheduled event.

Approved refunds will be processed within 7–10 business days.

3. Event Changes

- The organizers reserve the right to modify the agenda, speakers, venue, or schedule at any time without prior notice.
